FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

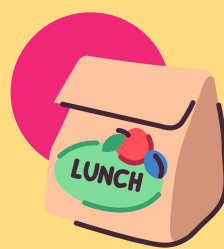
TECHNOLOGY & SCHOOL ID CARDS

All students will be provided with a school ID. IDs should be worn daily for safety and access. All freshman students will be issued a district device during the first few weeks of school.

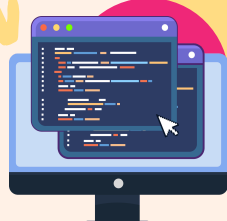


LUNCH TIME
