Techsploration Points

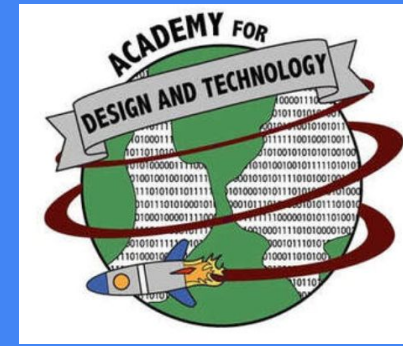
- Techsploration Points are awarded for tasks and activities outside of the classroom that align with the ADT pillars.
 - Signature Experiences (learning expeditions, travel opportunities, senior seminar and more)
- Self-selected Techsploration
 - Using online resources to teach yourself a new skill
 - Partnering with a local maker or expert to learn a new craft
 - Identifying a need in your community. Seek to better understand the need through interviews and additional research, then design a solution.
 - Reaching outside of the classroom to work with others (partnerships, community resources, global connections, etc.)

- Embrace ownership of their academy and high school experience

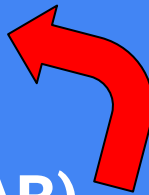
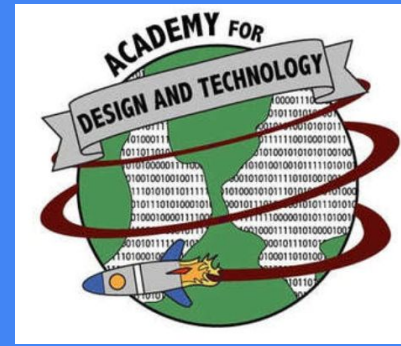
